PROCEEDINGS: ORDER FROM CHAMBERS

Before the Court is the Parties' Joint Status Report and Stipulation seeking to stay all scheduled deadlines and hearings in this matter ("Joint Stipulation").¹ For the following reasons, the Court **GRANTS in part** the Joint Stipulation and **STAYS** the deadlines and hearings scheduled in this matter for **60 days**. In light of the stay, the Court **DENIES** Defendants' Motion to Bifurcate² **without prejudice**. The Parties are **ORDERED** to submit a status report **30 days** from the date of this order.

In the Joint Stipulation, the Parties report that on May 4–5, 2021, they engaged in a mediation and "reached a settlement in principle on behalf of all Rule 23 Class Members and FLSA Collective Action Members."³ The Parties report this settlement "will resolve all claims pending before the Court" and that they are "working expeditiously to prepare a long-form Class Settlement Agreement."⁴ The Parties ask that the scheduled deadlines and hearings in this case "be held in abeyance while the Parties negotiate and draft the Class Settlement Agreement and seek preliminary and final approval of the class settlement."⁵

Good cause appearing, the Court **GRANTS in part** the request in the Joint Stipulation and stays the deadlines and hearings in this matter for **60 days**. The Parties are **ORDERED** to submit a status report **30 days** from the date of this order. In light of the stay of deadlines, the Court **DENIES** Defendants' Motion to Bifurcate at Docket 450 **without prejudice**.

Because the scheduled deadlines and hearings in this matter will be stayed for 60 days, the **October 4, 2021** trial date remains the same.⁶

IT IS SO ORDERED.
