Having considered the Parties' Joint Stipulation Granting Plaintiff Leave to File a Second Amended Complaint (the "Stipulation"), and good cause appearing therefore, the Court GRANTS the Stipulation and orders the following:

- 1. The May 2, 2022 order staying this matter is hereby lifted.
- 2. Plaintiff is granted leave to file a Second Amended Complaint ("SAC"), which was attached to the Stipulation as Exhibit A, to add a cause of action under the Private Attorneys General Act ("PAGA") and limit the liability period to reflect the putative class action claims will cover only November 18, 2020 to the present and exclude any putative class members who were part of the *Hernandez* settlement. Plaintiff is ORDERED to file the SAC before July 29, 2022;
- 3. Peloton's response to the SAC shall not be due until 30 days after the SAC is filed.
