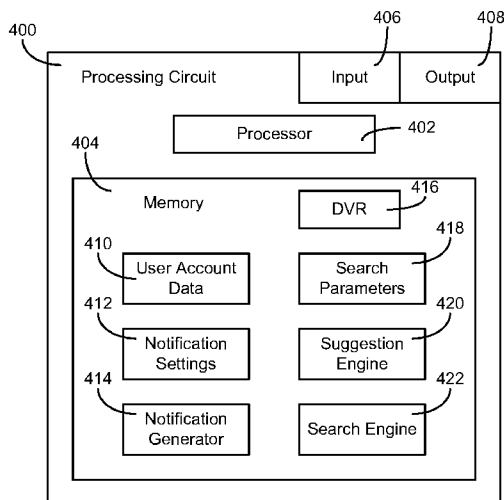

(57) **ABSTRACT**

Systems and methods for bookmarking media content for future availability are described. The method includes receiving a request for media content and user account data for a plurality of unique online content sources. The method also includes requesting content availability data from the plurality of unique online content sources and using received content availability data to generate a notification. Pricing information, the media format, and notification preferences may be used to further configure the searches and notifications.

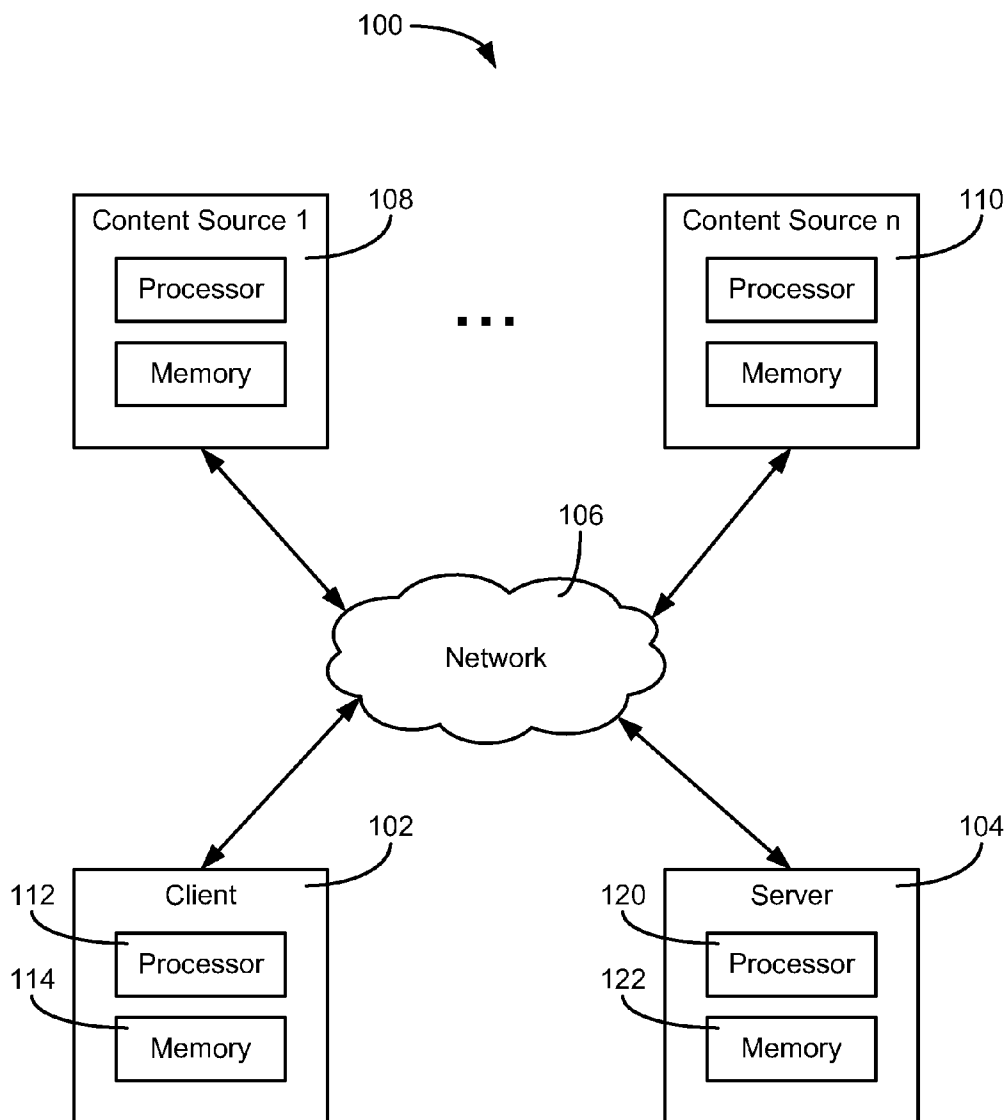

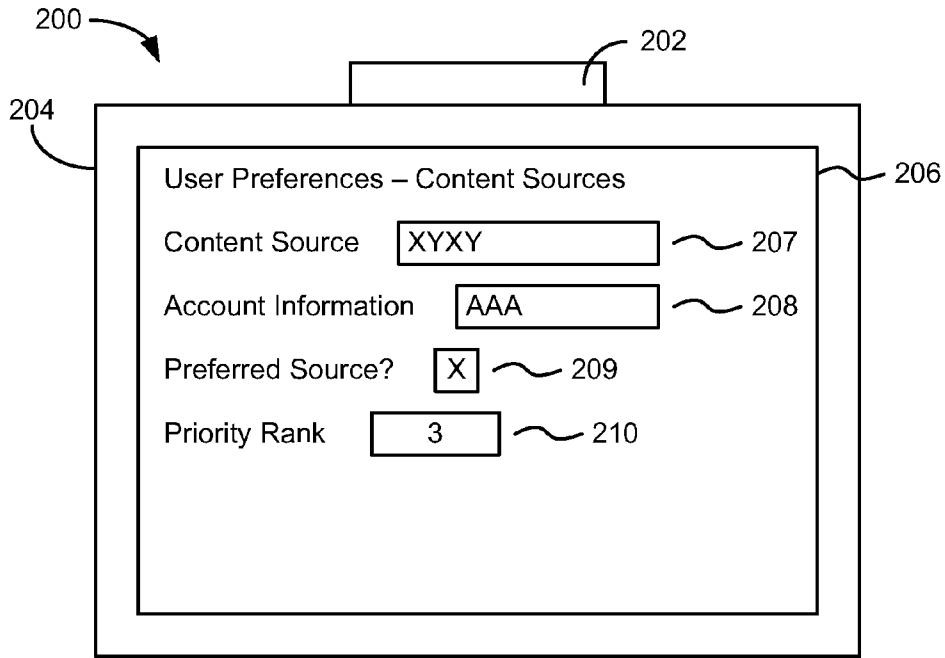

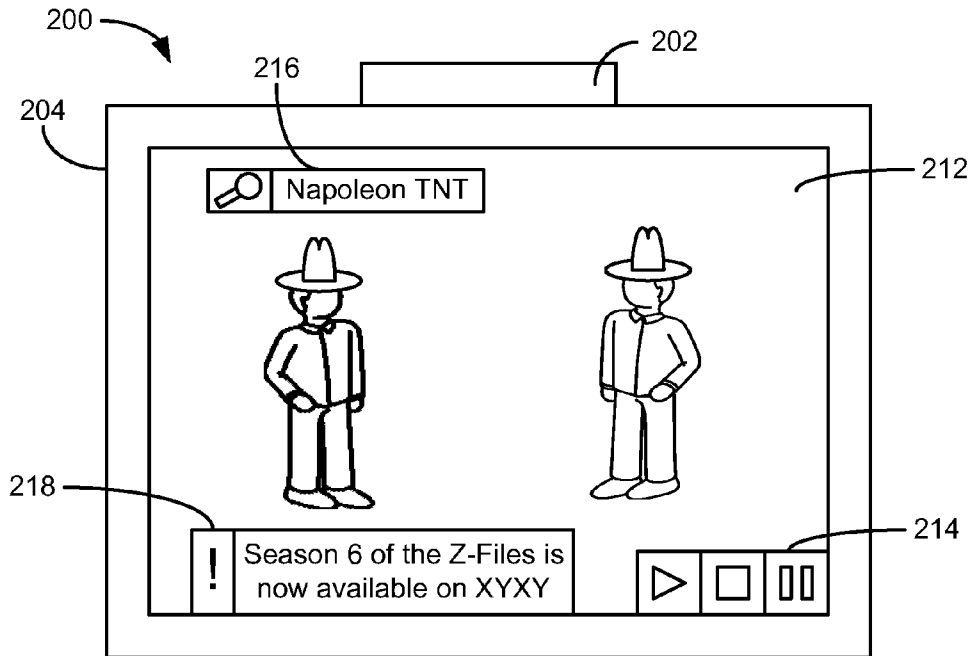

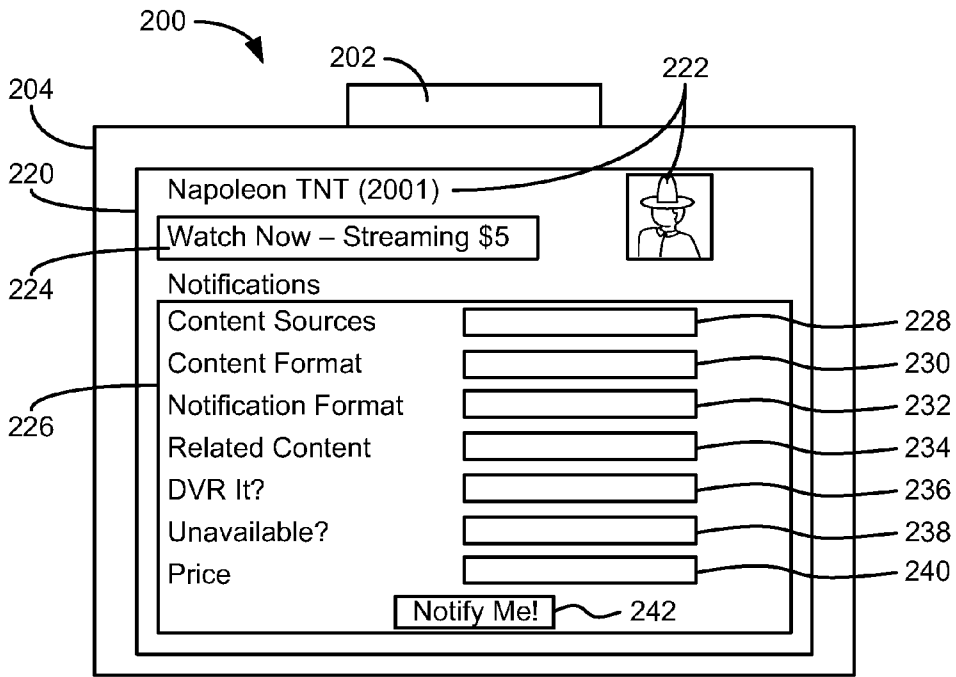

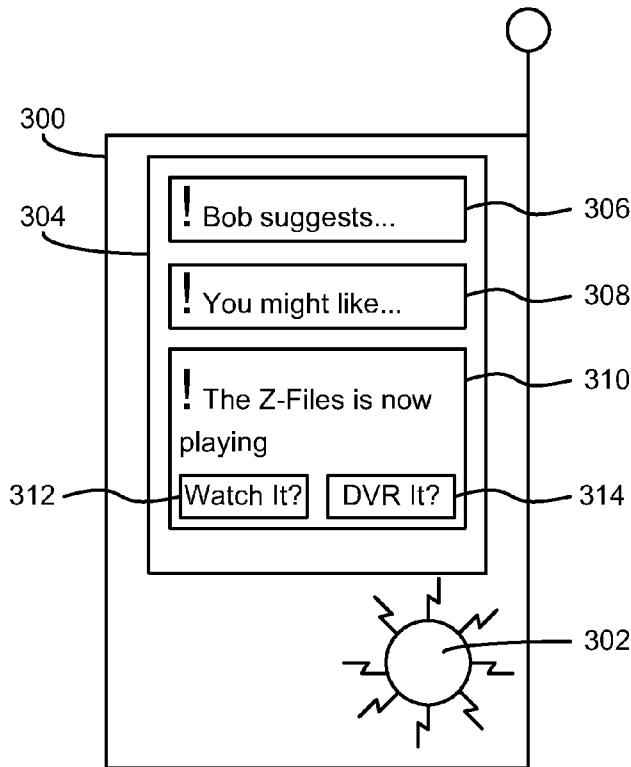
