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### **NOTICE OF MOTION AND MOTION**

#### TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR RESPECTIVE ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on October 21, 2021 at 1:30 p.m., in Courtroom 8 of the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, Robert F. Peckham Federal Building & United States Courthouse, 280 South First Street, San Jose, California 95113, the Honorable Lucy H. Koh, presiding, Plaintiffs¹ will and hereby do move for an Order pursuant to Rule 23 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure ("Rule"): (i) preliminarily approving the proposed Class Action Settlement Agreement and Release dated July 30, 2021 (attached as Exhibit 1 to the Joint Declaration of Tina Wolfson and Mark Molumphy, filed concurrently herewith); (ii) finding that, for purposes of effectuating the proposed Settlement, the prerequisites for class certification under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 23(a) are likely to be found satisfied; (iii) approving the form and manner of notice to the Settlement Class; (iv) approving the selection of the Settlement Administrator; and (iv) scheduling a Final Approval Hearing before the Court.
