
**THE COURT:**

Good cause appearing, the order of dismissal filed April 27, 2022, is vacated and the appeal filed January 27, 2022, is reinstated. Appellant is granted relief from any and all current defaults occasioned by appellant's failure to perform acts required by the rules of court.

The superior court's March 17, 2022 signed judgment of dismissal submitted concurrently with the motion to vacate dismissal is deemed filed.

Further, Appellant shall within 15 days from the date of this order perform any act for which the superior court has placed appellant in default. All acts (except for payment of fees) in compliance with this relief order are to be performed via the Los Angeles County Superior Court's electronic filing service provider. Payment of fees must be made at Room 111A at 111 North Hill Street, Los Angeles, California. Self-represented parties are not required to electronically file and may comply with this order at 111 North Hill Street, Room 111A, Los Angeles, California.

Appellant shall take immediate action to cure the default and, under no circumstances, shall appellant take more than 15 days to do so. If appellant fails to cure the default in a timely manner, the Clerk of the Superior Court shall immediately notify the Court of Appeal, and the appeal will be dismissed without further notice.
