## ORDER

On 17 March 2020, the parties filed a joint motion to continue the oral argument scheduled for 23 March 2020. *See* Joint Mot. to Continue Oral Argument on Def.’s Mot. to Dismiss Pursuant to RCFC 12(b)(6) and 35 U.S.C. § 101, ECF No. 23.
