## **INTERIM STATUS REPORT**

Pursuant to Paragraph 15 of the Scheduling Order (D.I. 20), Plaintiff Techno View IP, Inc. ("Plaintiff" or "Techno View") and Defendants Oculus VR, LLC ("Oculus") and Facebook, Inc. ("Facebook) (collectively, "Defendants") submit this Joint Interim Status Report to the Court on the nature of the matters in issue and the progress of discovery to date.

## I. NATURE OF THE MATTERS IN ISSUE

On April 6, 2017, plaintiff Techno View filed this patent infringement action against defendants Oculus and Facebook, alleging that defendants' Oculus Rift product, a virtual-reality gaming system, infringed the claims of U.S. Patent No. 7,666,096 ("'096 Patent"), directly and indirectly. D.I. 1. On May 22, 2017, plaintiff Techno View filed an amended complaint, adding allegations that defendants' Oculus Rift system also directly and indirectly infringed the claims of U.S. Patent No. 8,206,218 ("the '218 Patent"). D.I. 8. Defendants answered on July 17, 2017, denying all allegations. D.I. 12.



## II. PROGRESS OF THE DISCOVERY TO DATE

Discovery is ongoing. Under the Scheduling Order, the deadline to complete fact discovery is November 16, 2018. D.I. 20 at ¶ 8(a). The parties will notify the Court pursuant to the Scheduling Order should any disputes arise.

<u>Written Discovery.</u> The parties have exchanged written discovery to date. Defendants served Plaintiff with interrogatories and document requests on November 1, 2017. Plaintiff responded to these requests on December 1, 2017. Plaintiff served Defendants with interrogatories and document requests on June 7, 2018, and Defendants' responses are pending.

The parties exchanged initial disclosures on October 2, 2017. In accordance with Paragraphs 7(b)-(e) of the Scheduling Order (D.I. 20) and the parties' agreements: Plaintiff provided Defendants with its identification of accused products and claims on November 10, 2017. Defendants produced core technical documents on December 8, 2017. Plaintiff then provided Defendants with its initial infringement contentions on January 10, 2018. Defendants served their initial invalidity contentions on February 9, 2018.

<u>Document Production.</u> Document production is ongoing. The deadline for substantial production of documents is July 17, 2018. D.I. 20 at ¶ 8(b).

<u>Claim Construction.</u> Briefing on claim construction is complete, and a *Markman* hearing is set for June 19, 2018 starting at 11:00 a.m.

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
