
AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

AND NOW, this 23rd day of April, 2019, after a telephone scheduling conference, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

- Final infringement and invalidity contentions deadline is **August 15, 2019**;
- Opening expert reports deadline is **October 17, 2019**;
- Rebuttal expert reports deadline is **December 19, 2019**;
- Supplemental expert reports deadline is **February 14, 2020**;
- Expert Discovery deadline is **June 12, 2020**;
- An in-court Status Conference will be held on **July 1, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. in Courtroom 4B, James A. Byrne United States Courthouse, 601 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania**. At this conference, the parties shall be prepared to discuss whether motions for summary judgment should be filed. Any party seeking to file a summary judgment motion shall, on or before July 1, 2020, file a three (3) page letter explaining why, in light of the fact that the case will be resolved by a bench trial, summary judgment is appropriate. No motions for summary judgement shall be filed unless discussed with the court at the July 1, 2020 status conference and the court deems such motion practice appropriate;

- Daubert motion opening briefs are due **July 13, 2020**;
- Daubert motion answering briefs are due **July 27, 2020**;
- Exchange of witness list is due **September 1, 2020**;
- Exchange of rebuttal witness list is due **September 15, 2020**;
- A proposed pretrial order shall be submitted on or before **October 1, 2020**;
- A Final Pretrial Conference will be held on **October 13, 2020 in Courtroom 4B, James A. Byrne United States Courthouse, 601 Market Street, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.**
- This case will be listed for **TRIAL on October 19, 2020**. The location of the trial (e.g. Philadelphia or Wilmington) and number of days for trial will be discussed at the July 1, 2020 status conference.
