

AMENDED ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On October 24, 2023, the Court issued an order to show cause why the conditions of Defendant Jacion Wilson’s probation should not be revoked based on an alleged violation report issued by the Court Services and Offender Supervision Agency for the District of Columbia (“CSOSA”) on October 23, 2023.¹ Upon consideration of an additional report issued by CSOSA on April 3, 2024, it is, this 10th day of April 2024, hereby:

ORDERED that JACION WILSON be and is hereby ordered to appear on **April 12, 2024**, at **10:00am** in **courtroom 303** of the Superior Court of the District of Columbia, 500 Indiana Avenue N.W., Washington, D.C. 20001, to show cause why the conditions of his probation imposed on **April 29, 2022**, should not be revoked because of the purported violation alleged in the report dated April 3, 2024, in addition to the previous show cause order still pending.²
