Brookfield Renewable, (Brookfield), on behalf of its wholly owned subsidiaries Erie Boulevard Hydropower LP and FH Opco LLC, is hereby notifying the FERC of the installation status of seasonal boater safety devices (a.k.a boat balls or buoys) for the subject Projects listed above. Attachment 1 shows that with the exception of the Varick Development all impoundment boater safety devices were successfully deployed in accordance with Erie's required Public Safety Plans and prior to the Memorial Day weekend. Additionally, Attachment 2 shows the developments where Erie has installed tailrace boater safety devices. With the exception of the Beebee Island, Black River, Minetto, Colton, and Hannawa developments all other identified tailrace boater safety devices have been installed. The boater safety devices that have not been deployed are planned to be repaired or re-installed as soon as flows safely permit river access.
