Basis for Intervening:

Versado Gas Processors, L.L.C. (Versado) has a direct interest in the subject proceeding as a shipper under interruptible transportation agreements and a party to Operational Balancing Agreements (OBA) with El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C. (EPNG). The complaint in this proceeding requests relief in the form of a Commission order directing EPNG to waive all Critical Operating Conditions (COC) penalties assessed during the period of market disruption caused by winter storm Uri. EPNG assessed such COC penalties against Versado. Accordingly, Versado's interests may be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding. Other parties to this proceeding cannot adequately represent Versado's interests, and its participation in this proceeding will not prejudice the rights of any party. In light of Versado's interests in this proceeding, its intervention is in the public interest.
