

APPELLANT'S MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD ON APPEAL

COMES NOW the Appellant, VICTOR TONY JONES, through undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.300 and 9.200(f), files this motion to supplement the record on appeal in the above-styled cause.

Mr. Jones is a death-sentenced Florida inmate. His case is before this Court on appeal from the circuit court's denial of Jones's successive motion for postconviction relief. By order dated August 24, 2015, this Court directed that the record on appeal should be prepared in accordance with Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.200. The record on appeal was submitted on November 6, 2015. On November 10, 2015, this Court issued a briefing schedule. Jones's initial brief is being filed today, simultaneously with this motion.

A review of the Record on Appeal provided to undersigned counsel revealed that Defendant's Witness and Exhibit List, which Jones filed in open court at the
