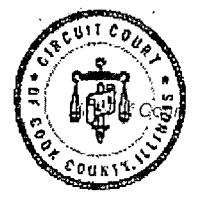

CLASS ACTION COMPLAINT

Plaintiff Maeteam Johnson (“Plaintiff”), individually and on behalf of all others similarly situated (the “Class”), by and through her attorneys, brings the following Class Action Complaint (“Complaint”) pursuant to the Illinois Code of Civil Procedure, 735 ILCS §§ 5/2-801 and 2-802, against Defendants Ralphs Grocery Company d/b/a Food 4 Less Midwest (“Food 4 Less”) and The Kroger Co. (“Kroger”) (collectively, “Defendants”), their subsidiaries and affiliates, to redress and curtail each Defendants’ unlawful collection, use, storage, and disclosure of Plaintiff’s sensitive and proprietary biometric data. Plaintiff alleges as follows upon personal knowledge as to herself, her own acts and experiences and, as to all other matters, upon information and belief, including investigation conducted by her attorneys.

NATURE OF THE ACTION

1. Defendant Food 4 Less is a grocery store chain in the “Kroger Family of Companies” and is a subsidiary of Kroger.¹
