## Dear Dr. Arunachalam:

The Commission is in receipt of your November 30, 2017, email requesting a postponement of the deadline by which the Commission must decide whether to institute a Section 337 investigation concerning Certain IoT Devices and Components Thereof (IoT, the Internet of Things – Web Applications Displayed on a Web Browser) (Docket No. 3263).

Under Commission Rule 210.10(a)(1), 19 C.F.R. § 210.10(a)(1), the Commission may extend the deadline for voting on institution of an investigation based upon a request by a complainant. Rule 210.10(a)(4), 19 C.F.R. § 210.10(a)(4), authorizes the Commission to reschedule the determination on institution "for whatever date is appropriate in light of the facts."

The Commission has determined to postpone its vote on institution, and has determined that the new deadline is set for January 9, 2018. Postponing the vote on whether to institute would provide you with additional time to address the issues raised by OUII in its November 28, 2017 letter, and for OUII to consider any additional information that you submit. Please keep the Office of Unfair Import Investigations ("OUII") apprised of the status of your amended complaint.
