Dear Dr. Arunachalam:

Under Commission Rule 210.10(a)(1), 19 C.F.R. § 210.10(a)(1), the Commission may extend the 30-day deadline for voting on institution of an investigation when "[e]xceptional circumstances preclude adherence to a 30-day deadline." Rule 210.10(a)(2) further provides that "[i]f exceptional circumstances preclude Commission adherence for the 30-day deadline for determining whether to institute an investigation on the basis of the complaint, the determination will be made as soon after that deadline as possible."

Due to the number of allegations set forth in the Amended Complaint and the number of proposed respondents, the Commission will need additional time to review all of the submissions. Thus, the Commission has determined to postpone its vote on institution, and has determined that the new deadline is set for January 12, 2018.
