ORDER NO. 6: SETTING DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(August 8, 2018)

The joint proposed procedural schedule should be received by the undersigned no later than close of business on August 17, 2018. Said proposed procedural schedule should include dates for each of the events set forth in Ground Rule 2 (if applicable). Based on a review of the undersigned's current caseload, the *Markman* hearing¹ will take place on November 7, 2018 and the evidentiary hearing will be held July 15–19, 2019. The parties should take these dates into consideration when proposing their procedural schedule.

The proposed schedule includes dates for two settlement meetings and one mediation (which will not include the Administrative Law Judge) at a time, date, and location of the parties choosing for the exploration of settlement, by persons of requisite authority, of some or all of the issues in the case. Unless the parties obtain the permission of the undersigned, for good cause shown, the settlement meetings should <u>not</u> occur by video-conferencing or by teleconferencing.

¹ All parties believe the undersigned should impose a limitation on the number of terms to be construed. (See Joint Discovery Statement at \P 3.i.) Complainant suggests three terms per asserted patent. (Id.) Respondents propose that the parties be limited to fifteen terms for all of the asserted patents. (Id.) The Commission Investigative Staff believes the number of disputed terms should be limited to three claim terms per asserted patent or no more than fifteen claim terms for all of the asserted patents. (Id.) Since all parties are in agreement that the number of claim terms be limited, the undersigned is hereby imposing a limit of no more than fifteen claim terms for the five asserted patents.

Pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.42(h), this Initial Determination shall become the determination of the Commission unless a party files a petition for review of the Initial Determination pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.43(a), or the Commission, pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.44, orders, on its own motion, a review of the Initial Determination or certain issues herein.
