An initial case management conference will be held on August 28, 2018, at the U.S. International Trade Commission in Washington, DC. The preliminary conference will begin at 9:00 a.m. ET. At the conference the parties should be prepared to discuss the following:


- A. formulating and simplifying the issues, and eliminating frivolous claims or defenses;
- B. amending the pleadings if necessary or desirable;
- C. obtaining admissions and stipulations about facts and documents to avoid unnecessary proof, and ruling in advance on the admissibility of evidence;
- D. avoiding unnecessary proof and cumulative evidence;
- E. controlling and scheduling discovery, including discovery involving non-parties;
- F. identifying witnesses and documents, and setting dates for further conferences if necessary;
- G. settlement and mediation;
- H. disposing of pending motions;
- I. adopting special procedures for managing potentially difficult or protracted actions that may involve complex issues, multiple parties, difficult legal

questions, or unusual proof problems, including the possible consolidation or severance of proceedings; and

- J. facilitating in other ways the just, speedy, and inexpensive disposition of the action.

The parties shall file a joint statement proposing a target date for this investigation no later than close of business on August 31, 2018.
