
**ORDER NO. 13: DENYING GLYCOSYN LLC'S REQUEST FOR SHORTENED
RESPONSE TIME**

On September 28, 2018 Complainant Glycosyn LLC ("Glycosyn") moved (1120-010) to compel Respondent Jennewein Biotechnologie GmbH ("Jennewein") to produce samples of those products identified in Jennewein's G.R. 7.2 mandatory disclosure. Glycosyn also requested a shortened response time for any opposition from Jennewein. (Mot. at 1.) No response to the request for shortened time has been received to date.

Having reviewed the pleading, Glycosyn's request for a shortened response time is hereby denied.


