SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation on July 20, 2018, based on a complaint, as supplemented, filed on behalf of Walbro, LLC of Tucson, Arizona. 83 FR 34,614 (July 20, 2018). The complaint, as supplemented, alleges violations of Section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1337 ("section 337"), based upon the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, and the sale within the United States after importation of certain carburetors and products containing such carburetors by reason of infringement of one or more claims of U.S. Patent No. 6,394,424; U.S. Patent No. 6,439,547; U.S. Patent No. 6,533,254; U.S. Patent No. 6,540,212; and U.S. Patent No. 7,070,173. The complaint further alleges that an industry in the United States exists as required by section 337.

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The notice of investigation named numerous respondents. The Office of Unfair Import Investigations was named as a party in this investigation.

On February 14, 2019, the ALJ issued an ID extending the target date for completion of the investigation due to the shutdown of the Federal Government until May 20, 2020. Under this schedule, the final ID on violation is due by January 20, 2020. No petitions for review were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the ID.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 C.F.R. Part 210).
