**ORDER NO. 31: GRANTING JOINT REQUEST FOR RECEIPT OF EVIDENCE

On March 28, 2019, complainant Glycosyn LLC (“Glycosyn”) and respondent Jennewein Biotechnologie GmbH (“Jennewein”), and the Commission Investigative Staff (“Staff”) (altogether, “the Parties”) filed a Joint Request for Receipt of Evidence Without a Sponsoring Witness. (EDIS Doc. No. 671581.) Specifically, the Parties request that the following categories of exhibits be received into evidence without a sponsoring witness: [1] copies of the asserted patent(s)<sup>1</sup>, file histories, and assignment records; [2] stipulations among the private parties regarding bond and importation; [3] discovery responses of Glycosyn and Jennewein; [4] designated deposition transcripts of party corporate representatives and employees; and [5] designated deposition transcripts of non-parties.

Having reviewed the pleadings, and there being no opposition, the joint request for receipt of evidence without a sponsoring witness is hereby granted. The parties are advised that


