ORDER NO. 50: NOTICE OF TELEPHONE CONFERENCE

(August 13, 2019)

A telephone conference (“Teleconference”) was held last week on Wednesday, August 15, 2019 at 2:00 p.m., during which a number of issues were addressed, including, but not limited to, the Parties’ request for receipt of evidence without a sponsoring witness.¹ (See Order Nos. 45 and 49.).

Another **Teleconference** will be held on **August 27, 2019 at 2:00 p.m.** That Teleconference replaces the tentatively, previously scheduled Teleconference for August 20, 2019. (See Order No. 49.). In other words, ***there will not be a Teleconference on August 20, 2019.*** The August 27, 2019 Teleconference will deal with all outstanding Motions *in Limine* (“MIL”) and High Priority Objections (“HPO”) that are ready for decision. Any other motions that are ready for decision may also be discussed.


