

ORDER NO. 35 NOTICE AND ORDER REGARDING MOTION TO SUSPEND AND  
MODIFY THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

(March 11, 2020)

1. On March 6, 2020, all Respondents moved to suspend and modify the procedural schedule in light of the ongoing COVID-19 outbreak. Complainant Neodron filed its response yesterday, March 10, 2020, so the motion is now ripe for decision. Although I intend to rule promptly, it is my understanding that the Commission intends to issue guidance on the subject no later than this Friday, March 13, 2020. Out of an abundance of caution, I will wait for that guidance to issue before resolving the question presented.
2. The parties have engaged in settlement discussions, which is laudable, and I expect to be informed of any settlement without delay. However, in informing me of settlement-related developments, the parties shall not communicate the substance of any negotiations. In particular, the parties are directed to not inform me of the dollar amounts of any demands, offers, counteroffers, or the like.


