ORDER NO. 4: GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION

On August 15, 2023, respondents NJOY, LLC; NJOY Holdings, Inc.; Altria Group, Inc.; Altria Group Distribution Company; and Altria Client Services LLC moved for a two-week extension of time until September 6, 2023, to respond to the complaint and notice of investigation. EDIS Doc. ID 802359, Motion No. 1368-01 at 1. The motion indicates that it is unopposed. *See id.*

Respondents state the additional time will allow them to investigate the allegations in the complaint more fully, to compile the information requested by Commission Rule 210.13(b), and to explore and develop potential defenses. *See id.*

There being no opposition and for good cause shown, Motion No. 1368-01 is GRANTED.
