**ORDER NO. 16: GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE TO

Complainants JUUL Labs, Inc. and VMR Products LLC, and respondents NJOY, LLC, NJOY Holdings, Inc., Altria Group, Inc., Altria Group Distribution Company, and Altria Client Services LLC move for an extension of the deadline to file responses to the Commission Investigative Staff's contingent motion for partial summary determination through February 6. Motion Docket No. 1368-007 (EDIS Doc. ID 812913) at 1. The Staff does not oppose. *Id.*

The responses are currently due on February 1. The motion states that good cause exists for the extension in view of the initial expert reports being due on February 2. *Id.* at 1-2.
