CONSTRUCTIONS (MOTION DOCKET NO. 1373-023)**



On February 21, 2024, Complainants InterDigital, Inc., InterDigital VC Holdings, Inc., InterDigital Patent Holdings, Inc., and InterDigital Madison Patent Holdings SAS (“Complainants”) filed an unopposed motion (“Motion”) for leave to file the Joint Chart Setting Forth Parties’ Post-Hearing Claim Constructions late. (Motion Docket No. 1373-023 (Feb. 21, 2024)). The Motion contains a G.R. 2.2 certification representing that neither Respondents Lenovo PC HK Limited, Lenovo (United States) Inc., and Motorola Mobility LLC (“Respondents”) nor counsel for the Office of Unfair Import Investigations (“Staff”) opposes the Motion. (Mot. at 1.).

Complainants assert that the Joint Chart was filed late due to technical issues. (*Id.*). Complainants further assert that the Joint Chart was filed at 6:03 pm ET on February 21, 2024. (*Id.*). Complainants argue that no party has suffered any prejudice as a result. (*Id.*).

For good cause shown, and because there is no opposition, the Motion is GRANTED.
