Dear Mr. Davis:

Under Commission Rule 210.10(a)(1), 19 C.F.R. § 210.10(a)(1), the Commission may extend the 30-day deadline for voting on institution of an investigation if exceptional circumstances preclude adherence to a 30-day deadline. Rule 210.10(a)(2) authorizes the Commission to reschedule the determination on institution for "as soon after that deadline as possible."

Due to exceptional circumstances, the Commission will require additional time to review this matter. The Commission has therefore determined to postpone the deadline for the vote on institution of the above-referenced investigation until December 5, 2023.
