9	FINDINGS OF FACT
10	Based on the pending Stipulation of counsel, and good cause appearing therefore, the
11	Court finds that:
12	1. Both counsel for the defense and counsel for the government need additional time
13	to prepare for the revocation hearing in this case. The parties have agreed to continue the hearing
14	for at least 60 days because defense counsel needs additional time to consult with Mogavero and
15	prepare her for the hearing.
16	2. Additionally, the parties have reached a negotiated global resolution to include the
17	revocation violations and a pre-indictment agreement regarding allegations of a new federal law
18	violation that has not yet been charged against the defendant. Mogavero is represented by
19	retained counsel, Mace Yampolsky, Esq., in the new law violation matter. Mr. Yampolsky, Esq.
20	has received a written plea agreement from the government memorializing the global resolution
21	and needs additional time to return a signed agreement to the government because he is out of
22	district until November 25, 2024.
23	3. The defendant is not incarcerated and does not object to the continuance.
24	4. The parties agree to the continuance.

1	5. The additional time requested herein is not sought for purposes of delay, but
2	merely to allow the defense sufficient time within which adequately prepare for the hearing.
3	Additionally, denial of this request for continuance could result in a miscarriage of justice, and
4	the ends of justice served by granting this request, outweigh the best interest of the public and
5	the defendant in a speedy hearing.
6	6. This is the sixth stipulation to continue the revocation hearing.
7	<u>ORDER</u>
8	THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the revocation hearing in the above-
9	captioned matter, currently scheduled for December 3, 2024, at 11:00 a.m., be vacated and
10	continued to a date and time convenient to this Court, that is on February 10, 2025, at the
11	hour of 10:00 a.m.
