**ORDER MODIFYING TERMS OF  
SUPERVISED RELEASE**

This matter having been opened to the Court by Defendant Carlyle Fraser seeking early termination of his supervised release pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3583(e)(1); Thomas Ashley, Esq., appearing for Defendant; Fabiana Pierre-Louis, Assistant United States Attorney, appearing for the government; and the Court having sentenced Defendant to a nine (9) month term of imprisonment followed by a one-year term of supervised release with special conditions; and Defendant's present term of supervised release set to expire on January 15, 2018; and the Court having considered Defendant's conduct, compliance with supervised release, full restitution, and the interests of justice; and for good cause shown;
