5. The balance printed on the most recent monthly statement recording a purchase transaction, last payment, or balance transfer was \$1,048.42.

7. Defendant(s) defaulted on the terms of the aforementioned Agreement.

There is now due and owing to Plaintiff from Defendant(s), as a result of the aforementioned breach of the Agreement by Defendant(s), the sum of \$1,048.42, itemized as follows: \$1,048.42, the total amount due at charge-off; plus \$0.00, the total amount of interest accrued since charge-off; plus \$0.00, the total amount of non-interest charges or fees accrued
