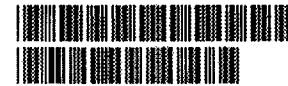


MILITARY STATUS
