**WHEREAS**, Defendants Lyndonville Central School District and Lyndonville Elementary School (collectively the "District") filed a motion for summary judgment pursuant to CPLR 3212 seeking dismissal of Plaintiff's Complaint in its entirety and with prejudice; and
