 4. Keep the Court and defense attorney advised of your address and phone number.
 5. DO NOT HAVE ANY CONTACT WITH ANY VICTIM OR WITNESS IN THE CASE. This ban includes direct and indirect contact by any means, including any form of electronic communication, such as email or social media. The ban also includes any harassing, stalking, or threatening conduct against these individuals, and any actual, threatened, or attempted use of physical force against them, which might be reasonably expected to cause bodily injury. Any prior Federal Firearms Findings remain in effect for purposes of the No Contact Order. ***If you have obtained an order modifying the conditions of release, the terms of that order apply.**
 6. Additional Conditions:
 - No driving without a valid license or insurance. No use of intoxicants while operating a vehicle.
 - No possession or use of any intoxicant. No driving any motor vehicle. No entry into bars or taverns.Other conditions: _____

Violation of these conditions may result in a warrant for your arrest, forfeiture of bail, and revocation of release along with any other consequences from any order or agreement issued in this case.
