Hi Andy,

As I mentioned in our conversation today, I am sending you this email to recap what we discussed. Rob is cc'd here as well and is aware of the direction being taken at this time. Since you are unvaccinated and are only medically approved to wear a shield, and not a mask, we cannot continue to have you working in your sworn capacity in the jail. As I also mentioned, below are some existing accommodations to be considered to allow you to continue in your sworn role in the jail. These options include the following:



- 1. Get vaccinated
- 2. Wear an N95
- 3. Transfer or demote to a non-sworn position
- 4. Take a leave of absence

Because of the nature of your work and mask mandate, MCCDA has signed an agreement with the County on this topic, attached, which provides agreement with the direction the Sheriff's Office has for the mask mandate and working in the jails. While the options listed above are very likely the only options for accommodation, I have also attached the accommodation request form that you may fill out and/or take to your health care provider for discussion on other options that may be considered for you. However, please understand that continuing to work unvaccinated in a shield will not be an approved accommodation, but we are open to consideration of any additional ideas you and/or your health care provider may have.

I will be in touch in a couple of days to follow up on this and see if there are other options you may wish to offer for accommodation. Please let me know if you have additional questions and don't hesitate to reach out.
