**PETITIONER'S REQUEST FOR REFUND OF  
POST-INSTITUTION FEES**

Pursuant to the Patent and Trademark Office’s Final Rule Setting and Adjusting Patent Fees, 78 Fed. Reg. 4212, 4232–4234 (Jan. 18, 2013), Sony Mobile Communications (USA) Inc. (“Petitioner”) requests a refund in the amount of \$18,000 to be paid to Deposit Account Number 50-2613.

On August 19, 2016, Petitioner filed a Petition for covered business method review of U.S. Patent No. 8,756,155 (“the ’155 Patent”) with the Patent Trial and Appeal Board. In accordance with the fee schedule specified in 37 C.F.R. § 42.15(b), Petitioner deposited an electronic payment at the time of filing of the Petition, including \$12,000 for fees associated with Petitioner’s request for review and a further \$18,000 for post-institution fees.
