On July 23, 2013 a conference call was held with counsel for the

The purpose of the call was for Xilinx to request authorization to file a substitute motion to amend.

Counsel for Xilinx explained that Xilinx's first substitute motion to amend (Paper 21) was filed prior to the Board's decision in *Idle Free Systems, Inc. v. Bergstrom, Inc.*, IPR2012-00027, Paper 26 (June 11, 2013). Xilinx seeks to file another substitute motion to amend in order to comply with the *Idle Free* decision. IVM does not oppose Xilinx filing another substitute motion to amend for the sole purpose of complying with the *Idle Free* decision.

Based on the facts presented and the facts of this case, Xilinx's request to file a second substitute motion to amend for the sole purpose of complying with the *Idle Free* decision is *granted*. The motion is due no later than **July 29, 2013**.
