DECISION

Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission

37 C.F.R. § 42.10

As authorized by the Notice of Filing Date Accorded to the Petition (Paper 5), Petitioner, Zhongshan Broad-Ocean Motor Co. Ltd., filed a “Motion for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Peter T. Ewald” (Paper 28).¹ Patent Owner, Nidec Motor Corporation, did not oppose the Motion. Petitioner’s Motion is *granted*. See 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(c); see also *Unified Patents, Inc. v. Parallel Iron, LLC*, IPR2013-00639, Order Authorizing Motion for Pro Hac Vice Admission, Paper 7 (October 15, 2003) (setting forth requirements for *pro hac vice* admission).²

It is

ORDERED that Petitioner’s Motion for *pro hac vice* admission is *granted*, and Mr. Ewald is authorized to represent Patent Owner as back-up counsel in IPR2015-00465;

FURTHER ORDERED that Patent Owner is to continue to have a registered practitioner as lead counsel in this *inter partes* review proceeding; and

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Ewald is to comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board’s Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Title 37, Part 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations, and that Mr. Ewald is subject to the Office’s disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a), and the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 *et seq.*
