We received Mr. Mandir's message regarding procedures that would be followed by the Patent Office for processing patent owner's request for Certificate of Correction. And we -- at the outset, I'd like to mention that, under 37 CFR 42.3, the Board takes exclusive jurisdiction over any involved application of patent during a proceeding. And so, going forward, patent owner shouldn't file any papers, including any requests, to any department outside of the PTAB while the case is pending before the Patent Trial and Appeal And, indeed, under 37 CFR 1.323, if a request for a Certificate of Correction relates to a patent involved in any trial before the Patent Trial and Appeal Board, the request must comply with the requirements of this section and be accompanied by a motion in addition to the request itself.
