software

A program by Richard Stallman (http://www.dictionary.com/browse/richard-stallman) to discover properties of the current platform (http://www.dictionary.com/browse/platform) and to set up make (http://www.dictionary.com/browse/make) to compile and install gcc (http://www.dictionary.com/browse/gcc).

Cygnus configure was a similar system developed by K. Richard Pixley in collaboration with Richard Stallman. In 1994, David MacKenzie and others modified autoconf (http://www.dictionary.com/browse/autoconf) to incorporate all the features of Cygnus configure and many GNU (http://www.dictionary.com/browse/gnu) programs, including gcc now use autoconf.

Metaconfig is a similar program used in building Perl (http://www.dictionary.com/browse/perl). (http://airs.com/ian/configure). (2005-04-15)
