## PATENT OWNER'S REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT

Patent Owner Uniloc Luxembourg S.A. hereby requests oral argument pursuant to 37 C.F.R. §42.70 and the Scheduling Order issued on April 18, 2017 (paper 7) in this proceeding.
