ORDERED that Petitioner's motion for *pro hac vice* admission of Anna M. Weinberg is *granted*, and Ms. Weinberg is authorized to represent Petitioner as back-up counsel in this proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner continue to have a registered practitioner as lead counsel in this proceeding;

FURTHER ORDERED that a power of attorney must be filed with the designation of counsel for Ms. Weinberg in accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(b);

FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Weinberg comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Title 37, Part 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations; and

FURTHER ORDERED that Ms. Weinberg is subject to the Office's disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a), and to the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 *et seq*.
