DECISION Termination of the Proceeding 35 U.S.C. § 317 and 37 C.F.R. §§ 42.72 and 42.74 IPR2017-00811 Patent 7,296,295 B2

I. DISCUSSION

On August 18, 2017, we instituted *inter partes* review with respect to certain challenged claims of U.S. Patent No. 7,296,295 B2 (Ex. 1001, "the '295 patent"). Paper 10, 45. Thus, this review is at a very early stage, and we have not yet reached the deadline for filing the Patent Owner Response. *See* Paper 11, 6.

On October 4, 2017, after receiving our authorization, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Terminate this proceeding (Paper 14) and a true copy of the parties' agreement to terminate the proceeding (Ex. 1010). *See also* Ex. 2001 (Stipulation of Dismissal). In the Joint Motion to Terminate Proceeding, the parties represent that they have settled all of their disputes regarding the '295 patent, both here and before the U.S. District Court for the Central District of California. Paper 14, 2, 3. Under these circumstances, we determine that it is appropriate to terminate this proceeding without rendering any further decision. *See* 35 U.S.C. § 317; 37 C.F.R. § 42.72.

II. ORDER

In consideration of the foregoing, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the Joint Motion to Terminate Proceeding for this proceeding is *granted*, and this proceeding is hereby terminated.
