DECISION Granting Patent Owner's Motion for Pro Hac Vice Admission of Martin E. Gilmore 37 C.F.R. § 42.10

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Gilmore is to comply with the Office Patent Trial Practice Guide and the Board's Rules of Practice for Trials, as set forth in Part 42 of Title 37, Code of Federal Regulations;

FURTHER ORDERED that Mr. Gilmore is to be subject to the Office's disciplinary jurisdiction under 37 C.F.R. § 11.19(a), and the USPTO Rules of Professional Conduct set forth in 37 C.F.R. §§ 11.101 *et. seq.*;

FURTHER ORDERED that Patent Owner must file an updated mandatory notice identifying Mr. Gilmore as back-up counsel in accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 42.8(b)(3); and

FURTHER ORDERED that Patent Owner shall submit, within seven (7) days of this Order, a Power of Attorney identifying Mr. Gilmore in accordance with 37 C.F.R. § 42.10(b).
