PATENT OWNER REQUEST FOR ORAL ARGUMENT
PURSUANT TO 37 C.F.R. §42.70(a)

Patent Owner Iron Oak Technologies, LLC, hereby requests an oral argument pursuant to 37 C.F.R. § 42.70. The Board has previously scheduled oral argument in this case for November 4, 2019.

Patent Owner specifies the following issues to be argued:

1. Whether Petitioner has met its burden of proving that claim 1 is anticipated by Sugita, or obvious over Sugita alone, or obvious over Sugita in combination with Burson, or obvious over Sugita in combination with Kirouac (with or without Burson), or obvious over Sugita in combination with Ballard (with or without Burson or Kirouac), including, in particular, whether Petitioner has shown that that Sugita alone or in combination discloses or renders obvious the requirement of claim 1 that the Manager Host is operable to decide *not* to send to a Second Mobile Unit the at least one discrete patch message that was sent to the First Mobile Unit even though the Second Mobile Unit is operable to create Patched Operating Code from the at least one discrete patch message?

Patent Owner requests the ability use video equipment (including use of a computer, projector, and screen) to display exhibits, including potentially demonstrative exhibits, during oral argument.
