September 1, 2020, commencing at 10:00 A.M. EST, by video/by  
telephone.

1 PROCEEDINGS

3 JUDGE VALEK: Good morning, this is the  
4 final hearing in IPR2019-01141. The Petitioner is  
5 New U Life Corporation, the Patent Owner is Axxess  
6 Global Sciences, LLC. This hearing is open to the  
7 public, and a full transcript of the hearing will  
8 be part of the record. I'm Judge Valek, with me  
9 is Judge Braden and Judge Chagnon.

10 Would counsel for Petitioner please  
11 identify who is present today on behalf of  
12 Petitioner and who will be speaking.

13 MR. GALVIN: Yes, this is Brian Galvin,  
14 from Galvin Patent Law. I am lead counsel for  
15 Petitioner, New U Life, and I will be speaking. I  
16 believe my backup counsel, Vanessa Bowman Pierce  
17 [ph], will be on audio only, listening.

18 JUDGE VALEK: All right. Thank you,  
19 Counsel.

20 Counsel for Patent Owner, would you please  
21 identify who is present today on behalf of Patent  
22 Owner and who will be speaking.

23 MR. HATCH: Good morning, this is  
24 Ryan Hatch on behalf of Axxess Global Sciences,  
25 the Patent Owner. And I'm the only one present

1 and I'll be speaking.

2 JUDGE VALEK: Very good. As indicated in  
3 the trial order, each side will have 45 minutes to  
4 present its case. I will be keeping track of  
5 time, but I suggest the parties do so as well.  
6 Petitioner will present its argument first,  
7 followed by the Patent Owner.

8 Counsel for Petitioner, would you like to  
9 reserve any time for rebuttal?

10 MR. GALVIN: Yes, I plan on reserving  
11 15 minutes for rebuttal.

12 JUDGE VALEK: All right. Counsel for  
13 Patent Owner, you may have the last word today, if  
14 you wish. Would you like to reserve any of your  
15 time?

16 MR. HATCH: Yes, I would. I would also  
17 like to reserve 15 minutes.

18 JUDGE VALEK: Very good. Before we begin  
19 the parties' presentations, I would like to go  
20 over a few things. First, on behalf of the board,  
21 we thank you, everyone, for your flexibility in  
22 participating in this all-video hearing. Given  
23 that this is a departure from our typical  
24 practice, I would first emphasize that our primary  
25 concern is your right to be heard. If, at any  
26 time during the hearing, you encounter technical

1 or other difficulty that you feel fundamentally  
2 undermines your ability to adequately represent  
3 your client, please let us know immediately, for  
4 example, by contacting the team members who  
5 provided you with connection information.

6 Second, to help with the transcript, we  
7 ask that you identify yourself each time you speak  
8 and mute your microphone when you're not speaking.  
9 Be mindful that there can be a lag in audio and  
10 video, so please pause before speaking to help us  
11 avoid speaking over each other.

12 The panel has access to the entire record,  
13 as well as your demonstratives, so if you refer to  
14 a page or the exhibit in your arguments, give us a  
15 few moments to get there so we can all be on the  
16 same page, literally.

17 And, then, fourth, plan to stay on the  
18 line afterwards to answer any questions the court  
19 reporter may have afterwards, regarding spellings  
20 or other clarifications for the transcript.

21 Finally, should you come to a good-faith  
22 belief that the pace of this proceeding prevents  
23 you from adequately explaining your position,  
24 please speak up and we'll consider some expansion  
25 of your time. There are no pending motions in  
26 this proceeding, therefore, it is our expectation
