4	JUDGE ANDERSON: Good morning, or afternoon, as the
5	case may be.
6	This is the final hearing on IPR2021-00381.
7	Petitioner is Apple, Inc., and Koss Corporation is the owner
8	of U.S. Patent No. 10,491,982.
9	Just a quick technical check. Counsel for
10	petitioner, can you hear me?
11	MR. RENNER: Yes, Your Honor. This is Karl Renner.
12	JUDGE ANDERSON: Just
13	MR. RENNER: And David, can you hear him on the
14	video?
15	JUDGE ANDERSON: Okay.
16	MR. HOLT: Yes.
17	JUDGE ANDERSON: Okay. Well, I've had a little bit
18	of a technical issue here so I want to make sure everybody
19	can hear me.
20	Mr. Knedeisen, can you hear me as well?
21	MR. KNEDEISEN: Yes, I can hear you. Can you hear
22	me?
23	JUDGE ANDERSON: Yes, I do. Okay.
24	With the technical issues resolved, let's proceed.
25	Administratively, I am Judge Anderson. We are
26	ioined in this hearing with PTAR Judges McKone and Beamer



1	We're all participating via teleconference so there
2	are some things to keep in mind.
3	Primarily is the need to identify the slides you're
4	using. I believe everybody's numbered them, so give us a
5	number, we all have a copy of your respective slide sets,
6	and we are able to follow along.
7	We also have copies of, I think, all for certain,
8	the most principal of the pleadings that have been filed.
9	Per our order, each party is going to have so you
10	can refer to the pleadings. That's what I'm saying to you.
11	Each party is going to have 60 minutes total to
12	present their argument. Petitioner has the burden to show
13	unpatentability and will go first, patent owner will follow,
14	and petitioner may reserve time to rebut patent owner, and
15	similarly, once the petitioner is through with its rebuttal,
16	if reserved, then patent owner may have whatever time is
17	asked for sur-rebuttal.
18	We don't have a timer, and that, for me, is a little
19	bit of an issue because I'm not a good multi-tasker, but I
20	will go ahead and make an effort. And I've asked Judges
21	McKone and Beamer to also assist me in keeping track of the
22	time, so we will have, hopefully, enough fire power to
23	actually tell you where you are in your reservation of time.
