

### **Exhibit F: U.S. Patent No. 8,266,212**


Pursuant to Paragraphs 1 and 2 of the Court’s Order Governing Proceedings – Patent Case (signed June 2012) (“IGT US”) provides the following initial claim chart (“Preliminary Infringement Contentions”) demonstrating infringement of U.S. Patent No. 8,266,212 (the “’212 Patent”) by Defendant Zynga Inc. (“Zynga”). Specifically, Zynga has infringed the claims identified in these Preliminary Infringement Contentions (i.e., claims 24, 27–29, 31, and 34–36 of the ’212 Patent) in the United States Zynga’s gaming methods involving hardware and software for publishing one or more of the items identified in the chart below, such as functionality for allowing users (e.g., third parties or Zynga during testing) to purchase items or other goods or services for Zynga games including, but not limited to, Words With Friends, Words With Friends: Potter: Puzzles & Spells, FarmVille, FarmVille 2, FarmVille 3, Zynga Poker, Hit It Rich! suits of slots games including, but not limited to, Money, Game of Thrones Slots Casino, Willy Wonka Slots, Wizard of Oz Slots, Black Diamond Casino slots, and Zynga Slots in IGT\_0004551 (Apple App Store), IGT\_0004583 (Google Play Store), and/or IGT\_0004424 (Zynga.com/games/IGT\_0004424 Methods”).<sup>1</sup> On information and belief, the Zynga games referenced in the below charts are exemplary only, and each of them exhibit the same accused instrumentalities common to all of Zynga’s Accused Methods.

Fact discovery has not yet begun, and these Preliminary Infringement Contentions are based on information provided to IGT US. IGT US expressly reserves the right to supplement and/or amend these Preliminary Infringement Contentions by supplementing any citations describing Zynga’s infringement of the asserted claims, or by amending with new Accused Methods and/or claims, or both—as the case progresses.

A method for distributed gaming over a communication bus, comprising:	<p>To the extent the preamble is limiting, Zynga’s Accused Methods comprise a method for distributed gaming over a communication bus.</p> <p>For example, Zynga’s Accused Methods allow users to access various games over a communication bus, such as the Internet or cellular network, connected to one or more servers owned, operated, or controlled by Zynga (“Zynga server”).</p>


