15 down to money.


16 So way back in 2013, Cowen and Company
17 reported that Bluebird Bio product would be around 7-
18 or 800,000, and even though it wasn't Bluebird saying
19 that, they had taken that from executives at Bluebird.
20 San Rocco Therapeutics always said that the product
21 would start out at 700,000 and then go down.

22 Our product was sabotaged. It's a safer
23 product. We use the wild-type beta-globin gene.
24 Bluebird uses a mutant gene. Most often the natural
25 genes or the natural way of doing things are safer.
