On July 18, 2017, we instituted trial for this proceeding. At this juncture of the proceeding, the Board does not have before it full briefing on the trial issues and the Board has not entered a final decision.

Based on the facts of this case, it is appropriate to enter judgment¹ without rendering a final written decision. *See* 35 U.S.C. § 327(a); 37 C.F.R. § 42.72.

It is

ORDERED that the parties' joint request that the agreement be treated as business confidential information, to be kept separate from the patent file is *granted*;

FURTHER ORDERED that the joint motion to terminate the proceeding is *granted*; and

FURTHER ORDERED that the proceeding is terminated.
