As part of the sale of its ISP division to Earthlink Services, Inc. in November, 2000, ISP customers may have claims based on the Debtor's failure to fulfill its pre-paid service obligations. The maximum obligation owed to any one ISP customer was \$75. There were approximately 17,500 ISP customers on the date of the division sale. As of this date, only a nominal number of rebate claims have been made.
