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


* Debtor was previously in the business of providing, among other things, ISP services (Internet dial-up service) to residential and commercial customers. Debtor's ISP services were provided to its customers on a twelve month pre-paid basis. As part of the sale of its ISP division to Earthlink Services, Inc. in November, 2000, ISP customers may have claims based on the Debtor's failure to fulfill its pre-paid service obligations. The maximum obligation owed to any one ISP customer was \$75. There were approximately 17,500 ISP customers on the date of the division sale. As of this date, only a nominal number of rebate claims have been made.
